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CAMP MOSHAVA VACCINATION/ IMMUNIZATION POLICY

Kayitz 2020

Every child and staff member must be up to date on all required vaccinations. The required vaccinations are in accordance with requirements of the State of Pennsylvania which follows CDC Guidelines.

All participants must have had tetanus boosters within the past ten years.

You must submit vaccination records annually. Records and medical forms are due on March 1 of the camp year.

Immunization exclusions are permitted on an individual basis for medical reasons only.

Philosophical/ Religious exemptions are NOT accepted by Camp Moshava.

Medical exemptions require:

1. A US Licensed Physician must write and sign a statement stating that the vaccine(s) required would be medically harmful or injurious to the health and well-being of the child or staff member.
2. A Moshava physician will review all submitted medical exemptions for accuracy and compliance with CDC guidelines and will make the final determination about each exemption's acceptance to Camp Moshava.
3. Accepted medical exemptions will be valid for a period of one (1) year from the date of signature by the Physician and will require annual renewal, unless it is written in the provider statement that a lifelong condition exists.

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
