

ADULT STAFF: Important: New Vehicle Policies, Vehicle Registration and Staff ID for Summer 2025

Dear Staff,

As we prepare for an exciting summer ahead, we want to share two important updates regarding the policy for bringing personal vehicles to camp and a new mandatory staff ID card policy. Please read the following information carefully and take the necessary steps by the deadline outlined below.

Staff ID Card (New This Year):

Every staff member in camp will be required to have a <u>staff ID card</u> (must be completed with a cell phone). Every staff member (young adult, mishpachot, tzevet bachir etc) will be required to present the staff ID card to the security guard at the gate upon departure and return to camp. Please note if you arrive at the gate to leave camp and you do not have your ID card you will be asked to turn around, retrieve your ID card and return to the gate (applicable to driver and all passengers in the vehicle). Staff ID cards will be distributed during pre plugah. Young Adult Staff must also receive permission from their Sgan before leaving camp property.

Please complete this form by Sunday, June 1st - <u>Staff ID card</u> (must be completed with a cell phone) Vehicle Registration Process (New This Year):

All staff members, including Mishpachot and Tzevet Bachir, who are eligible to bring a personal vehicle must complete the <u>Vehicle Registration Form</u> by Sunday, June 1st. This registration must be completed prior to arriving at camp.

Once registered, you will receive a car tag in the mail, which must be displayed and presented to security upon arrival at camp. Without this tag, you will not be permitted entry with your vehicle. Eligibility:

Only staff who are **post Shana Aleph and older** are permitted to bring a personal vehicle to camp. **To clarify: Post-11th and 12th grade staff may not drive any vehicle (including borrowing a friend or family member's car) under any circumstance**—this includes driving to, from, or during camp. **New Parking Assignments:**

- Camp Vehicles Only will be parked in the Guest House parking lot.
- Young Adult Staff will now park in a new lot located next to the maintenance shop.
- Mishpachot and Tzevet Bachir will park in the lot behind Nagarut.

We appreciate your cooperation and attention to these new procedures as they are designed to maintain safety and organization throughout the summer.
